ABOUT INTERNET ESSENTIALS

Internet Essentials is a free program that provides low-income families with the tools and resources they need to get online. This includes a computer, internet access, and digital literacy training. The program is available in select areas and is subject to availability.

SPONSORED SERVICE & HOW IT WORKS

When you sign up for Internet Essentials, you will receive a computer and internet access for a limited time. This service is provided at no cost to eligible households. The program is designed to help families get started with technology and improve their digital skills.

Eligible households can receive a computer and internet access for up to 12 months. The program is available to households with an income at or below 200% of the federal poverty level. For more information, visit [internetessentials.com](#).

ELIGIBILITY

Households are eligible for Internet Essentials if they meet the following criteria:

- A** All eligible households are required to provide a valid email address and a phone number. A household that is currently receiving a computer or internet access through another program is not eligible.
- B** Live in a household with an income at or below 200% of the federal poverty level.
- C** All eligible households are required to provide a valid email address and a phone number. A household that is currently receiving a computer or internet access through another program is not eligible.

WHO QUALIFIES FOR OUR PROGRAM

Individuals qualify if they:

Are a U.S. resident and a U.S. citizen or permanent resident. Live in a household with an income at or below 200% of the federal poverty level. Have a valid email address and a phone number.
