Total Enrollment

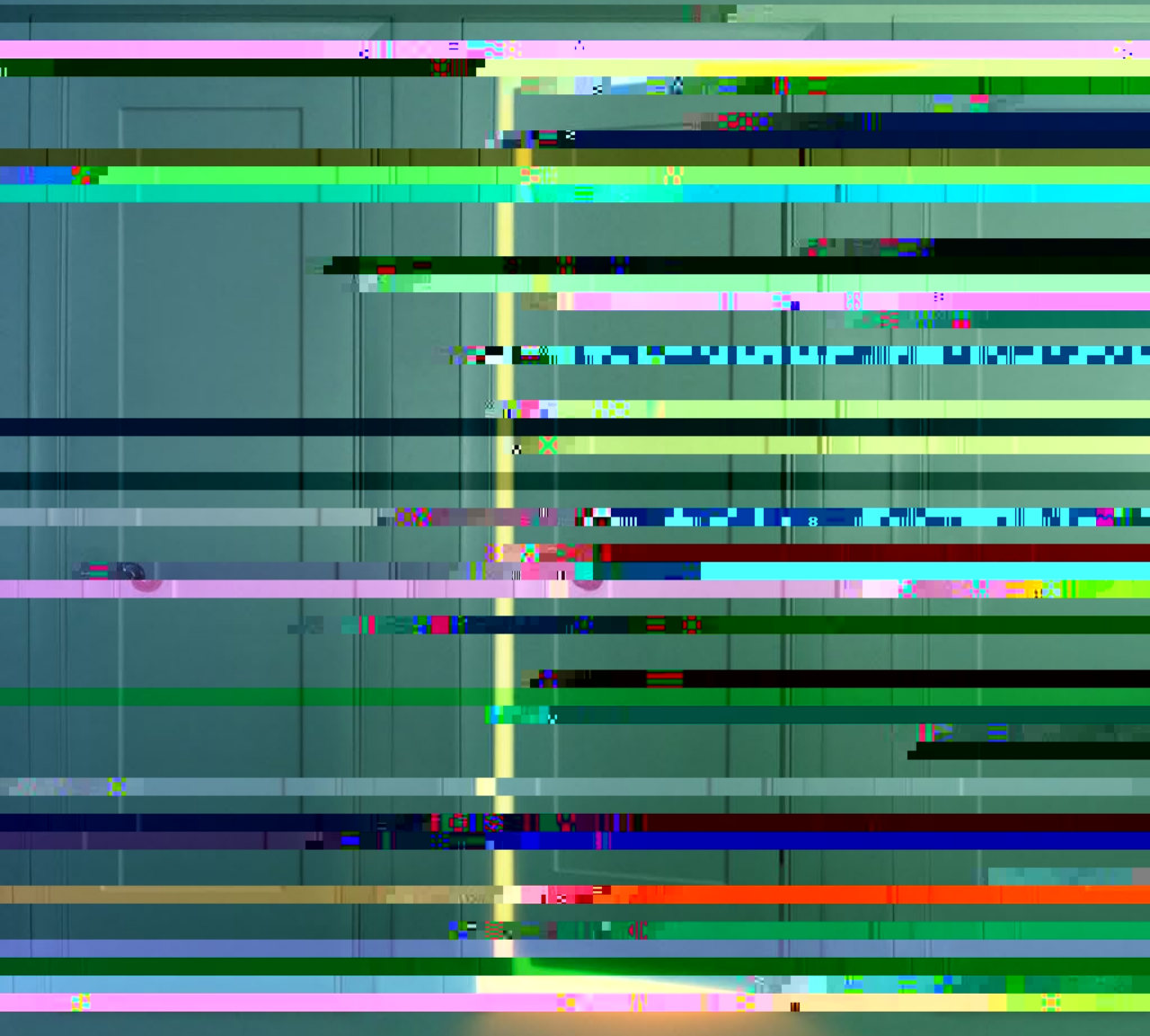






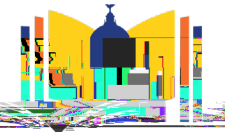

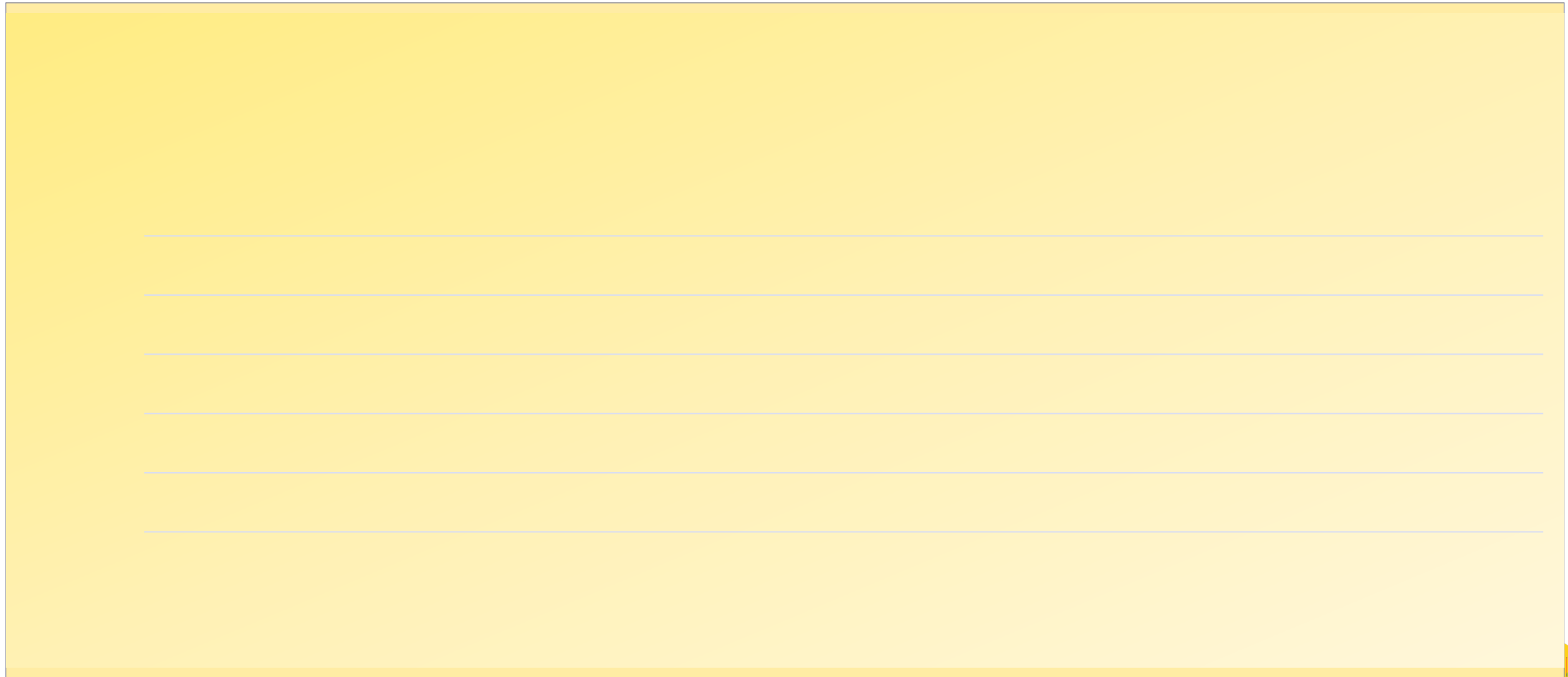

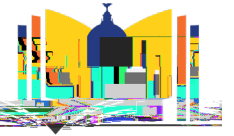


Revised Relocation Plans

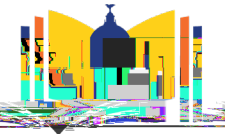
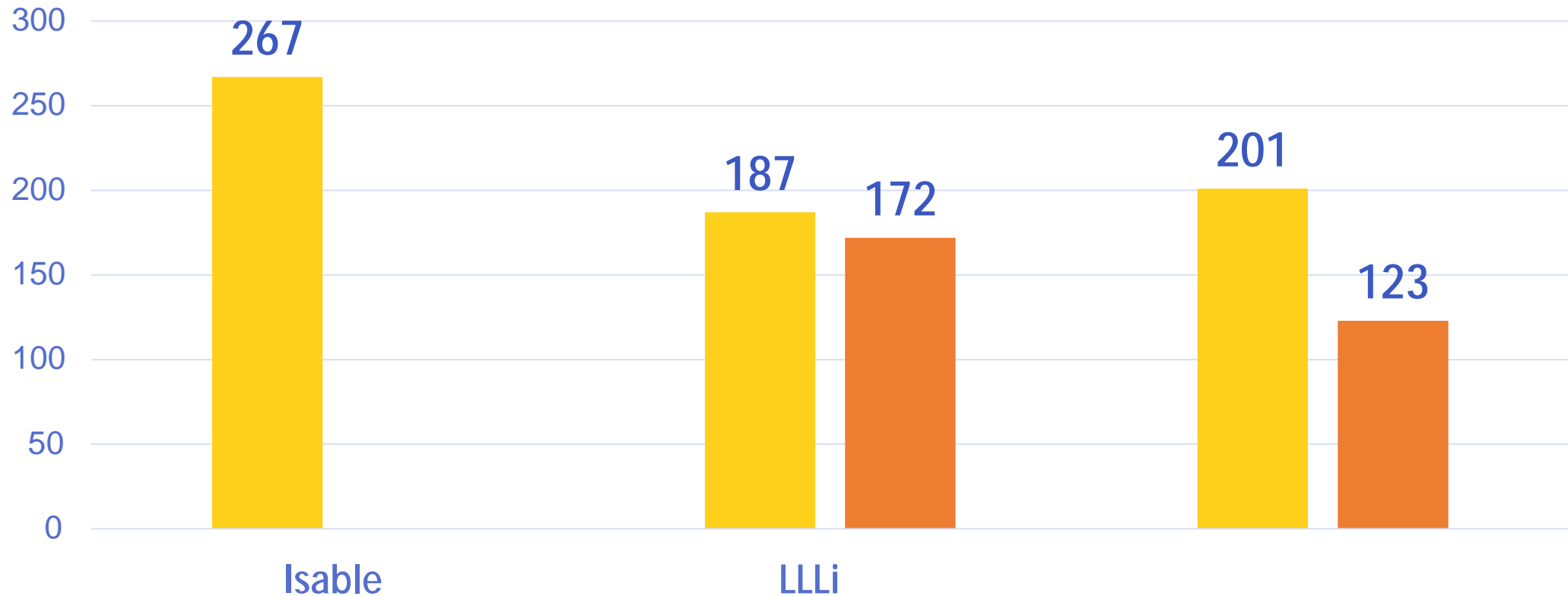
1. Accommodates siblings at one school;
